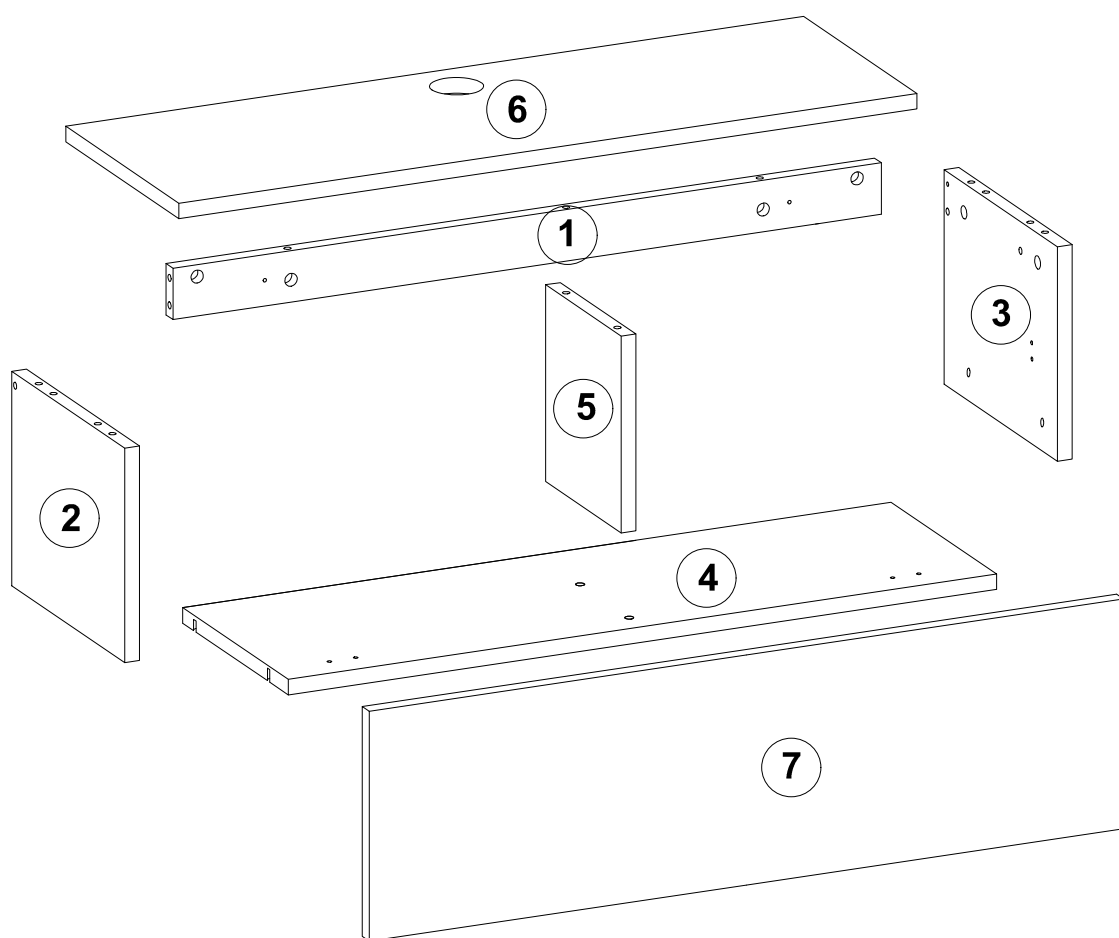


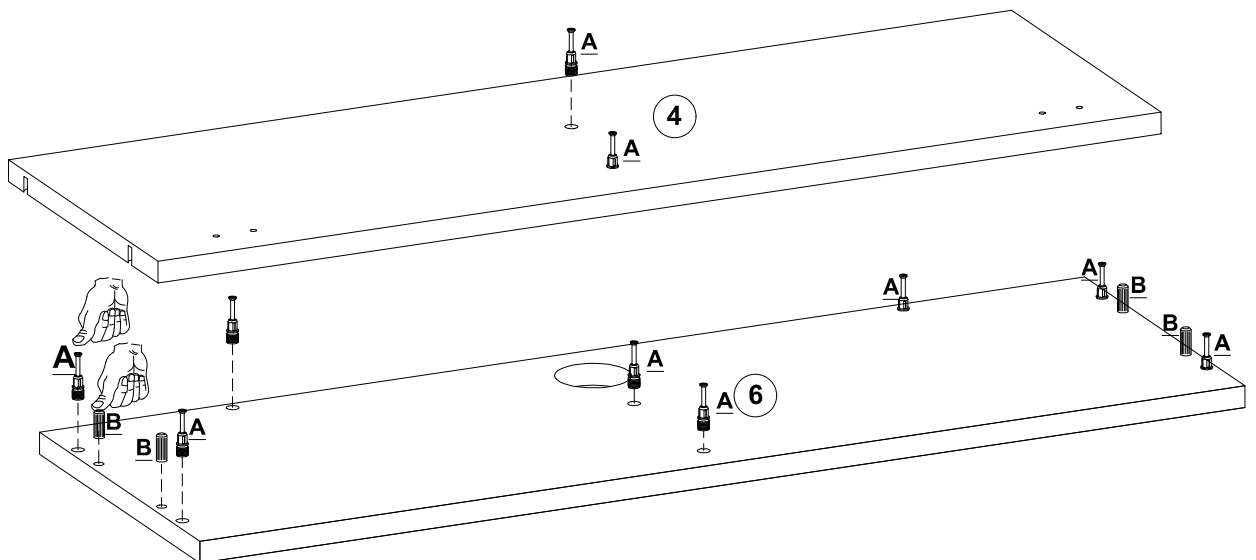
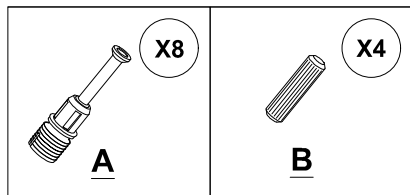
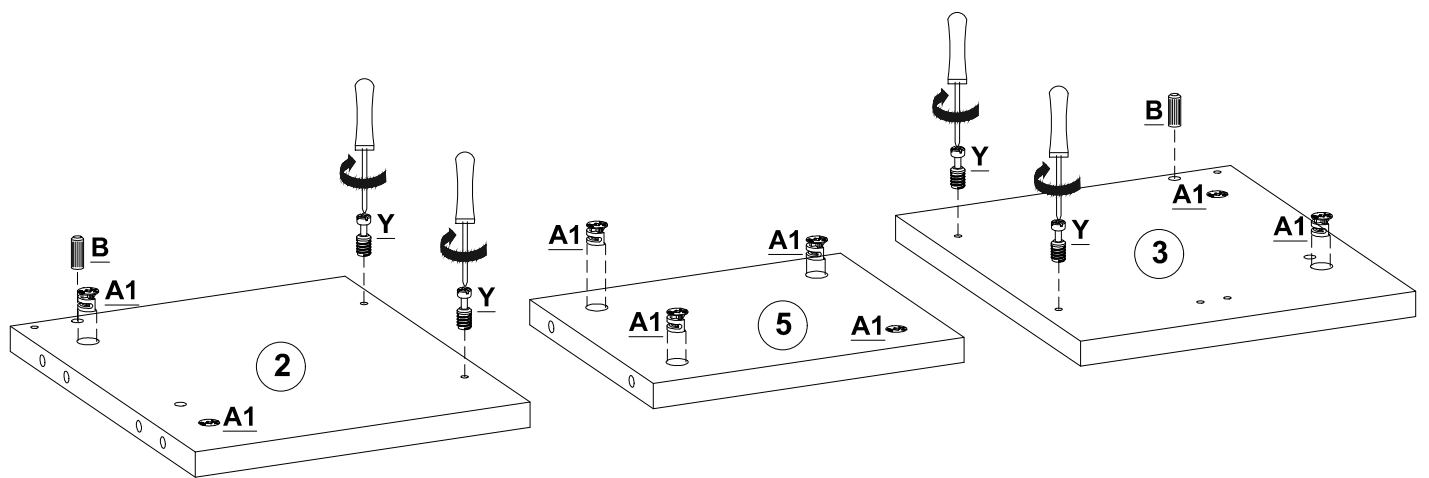
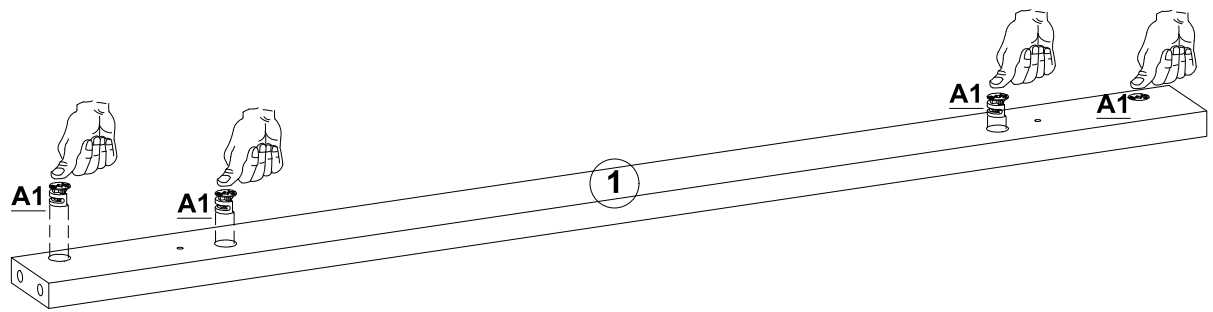
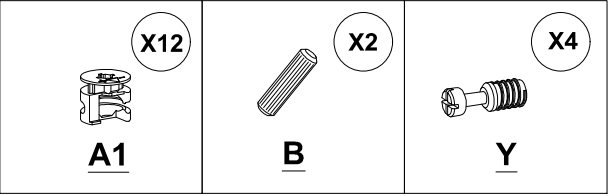


## Details on the use of accessories

## **WARNING! Please read this page.**

**Since the product you purchased will be installed on the wall, proper positioning is important. When mounting on the wall, first mark the total measurements on the wall. Then, drill holes according to the marks and proceed with the installation. To ensure alignment in side-by-side modules, check the level with a spirit level each time.**

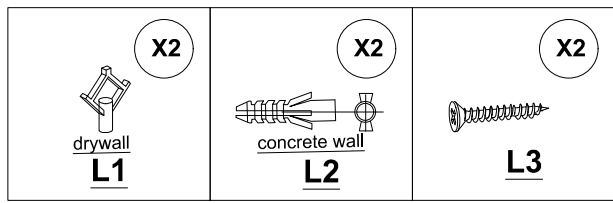
If you are uncertain about details such as wall type, thickness, or the location of electrical and plumbing installations, we recommend seeking professional installation assistance.

For ease of installation, you will need to use a power drill while following the steps below.

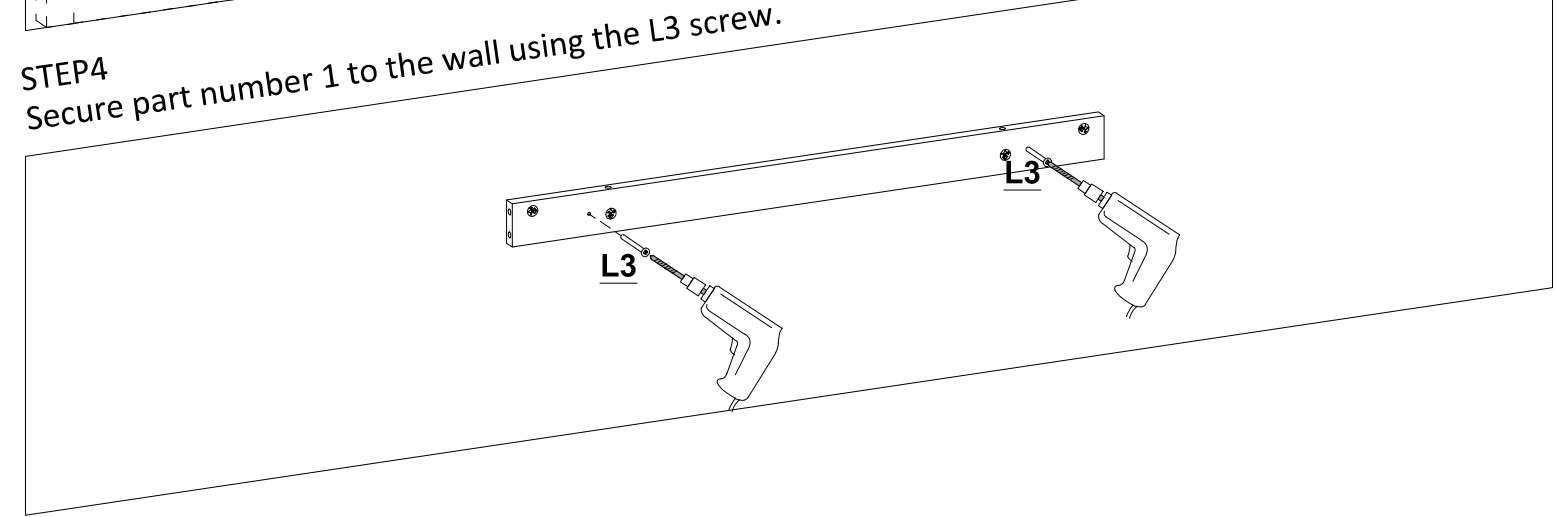
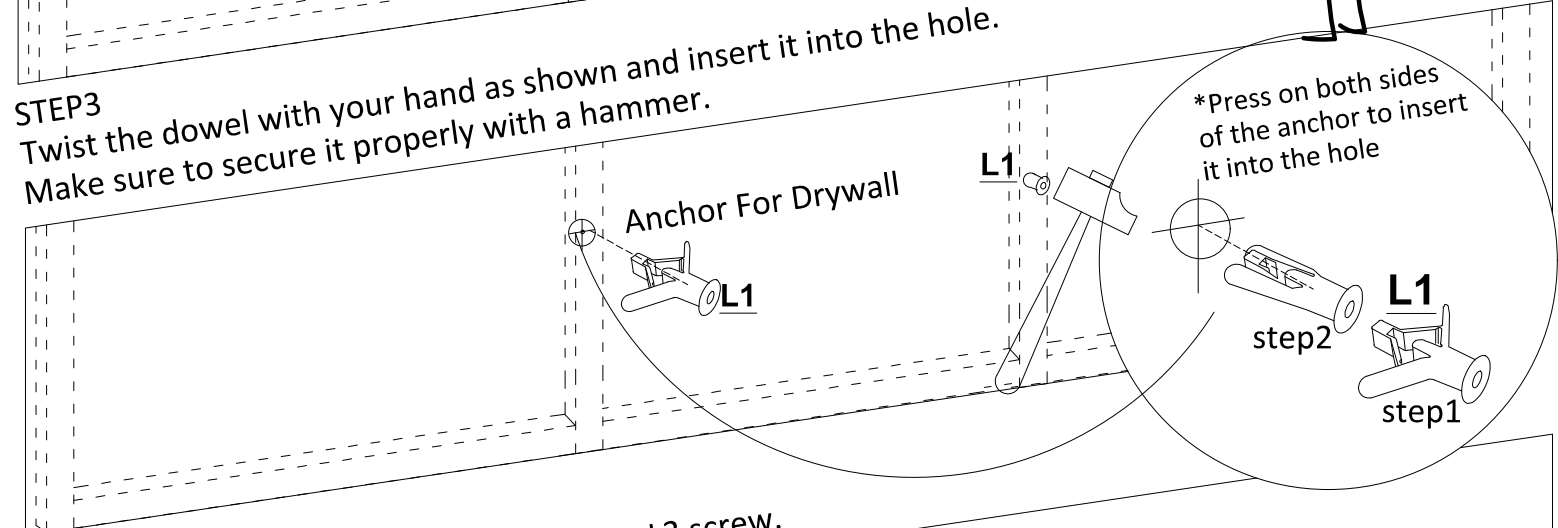
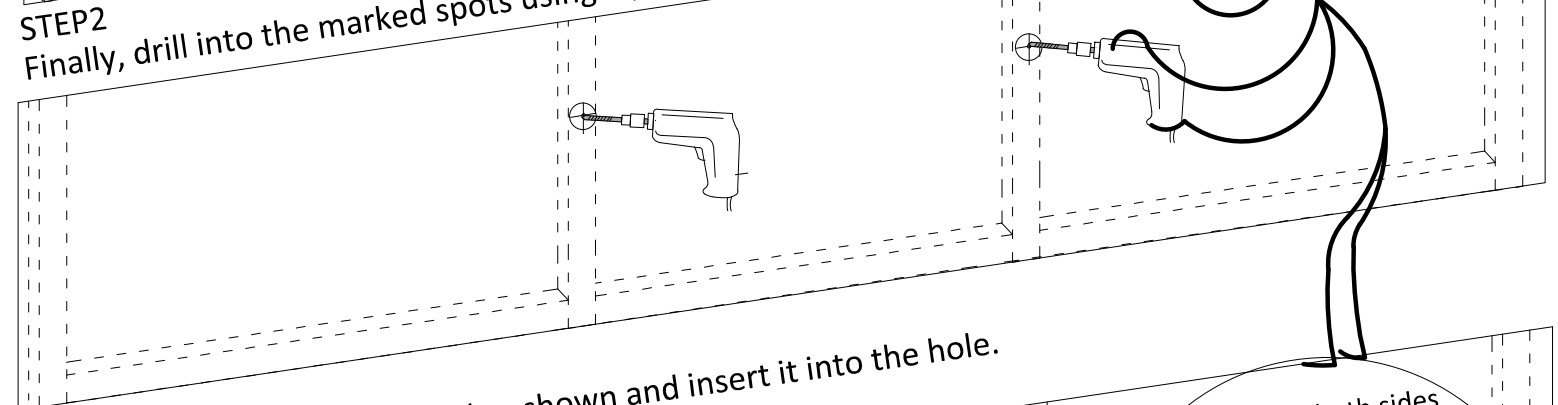
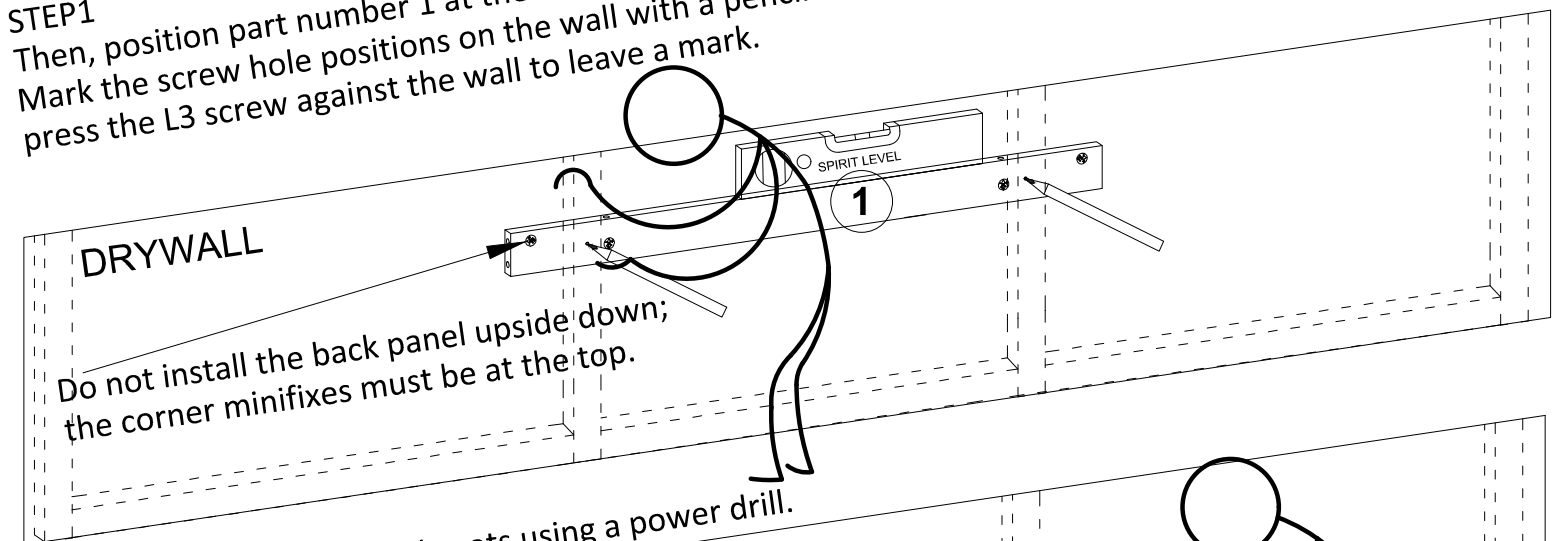
The box includes only drywall and concrete anchors with mounting screws. Use anchors and screws suitable for your walls. Carefully read and follow each step of the instructions.

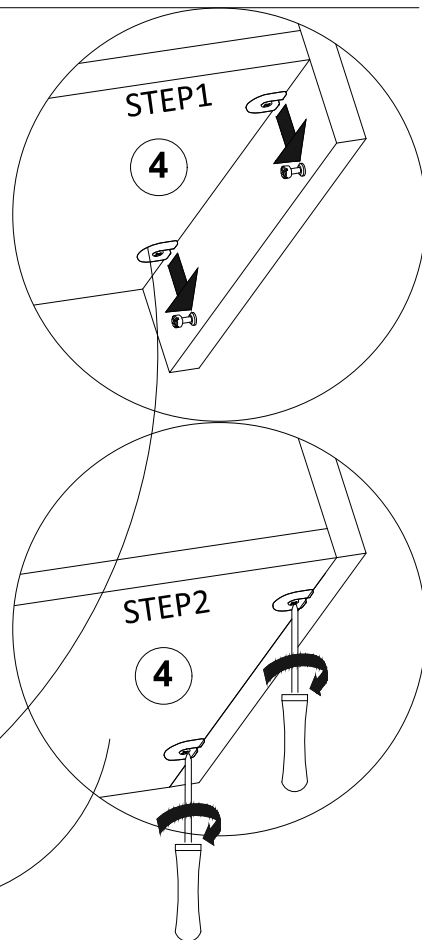
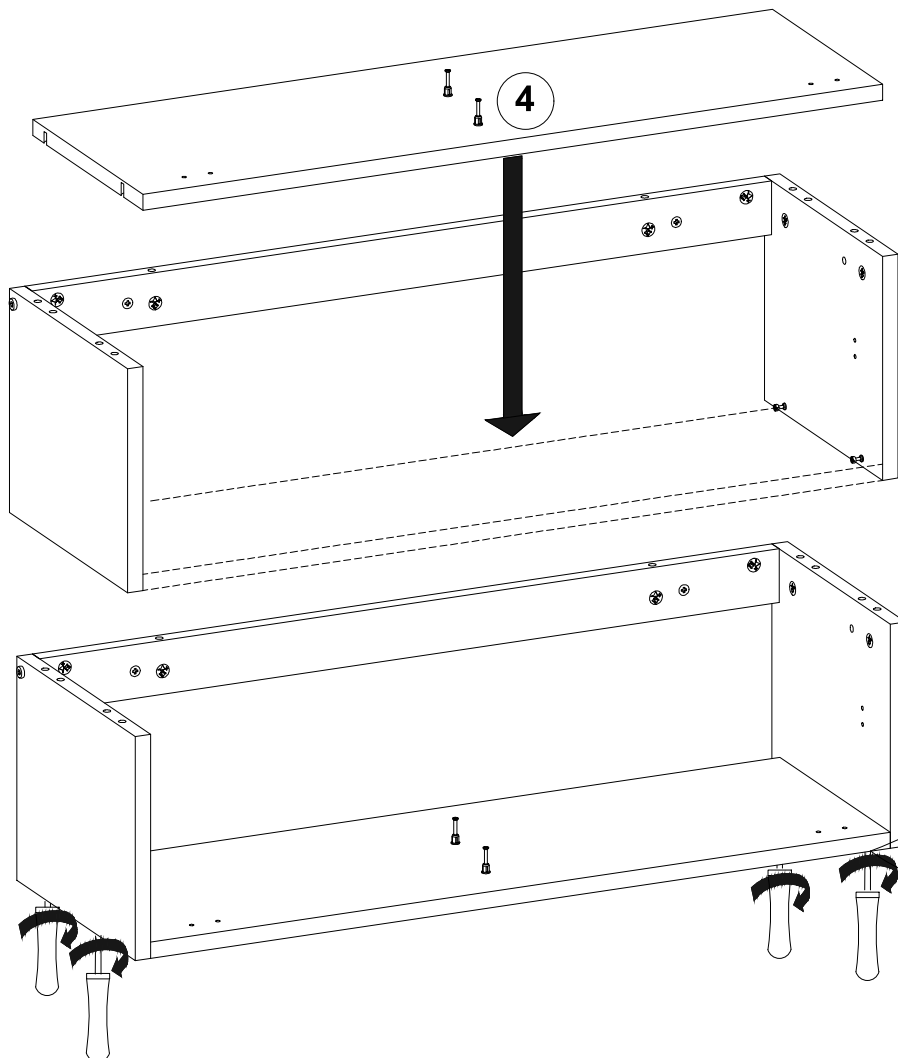
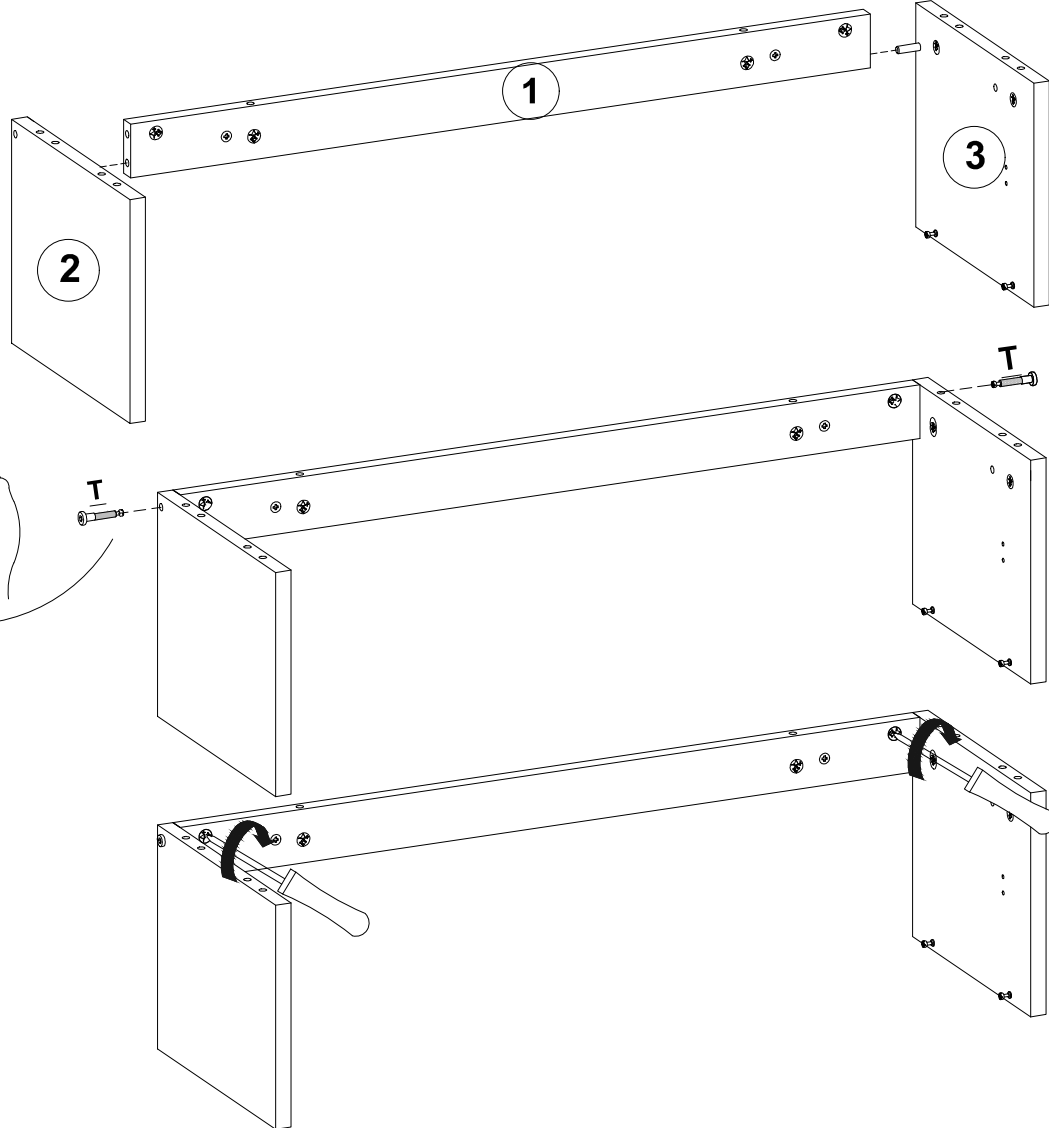
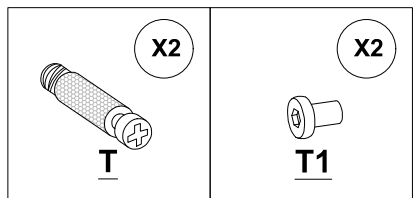

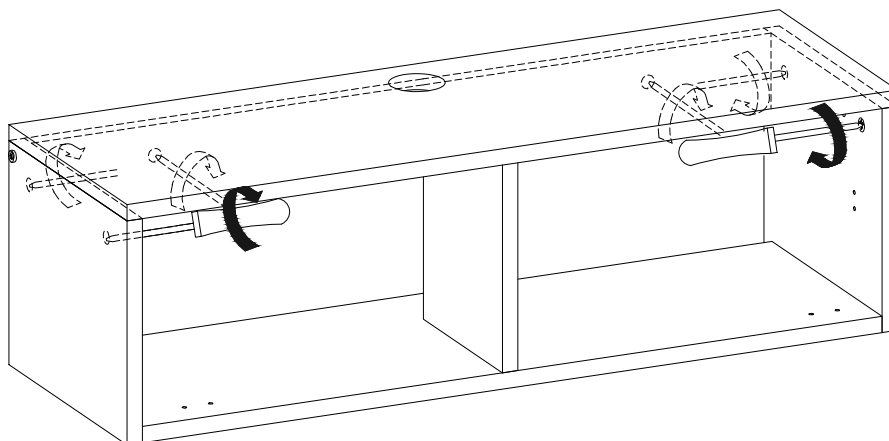
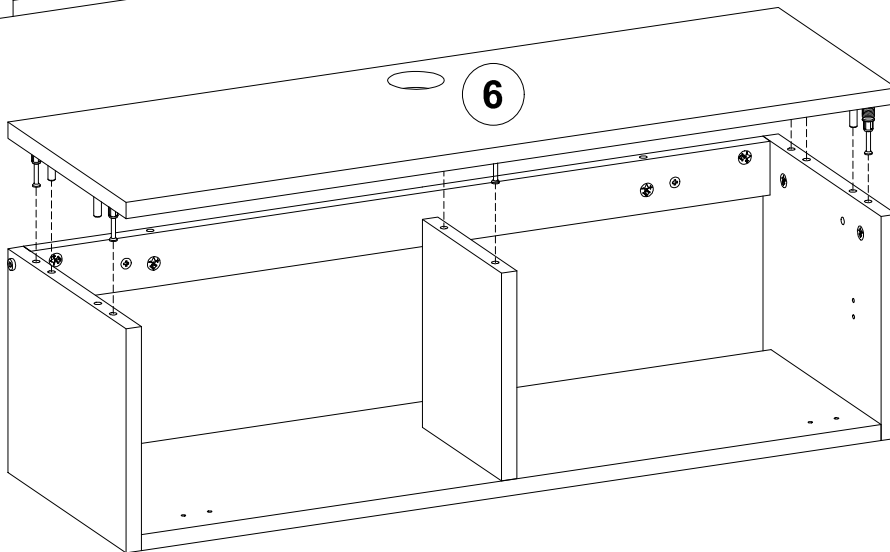
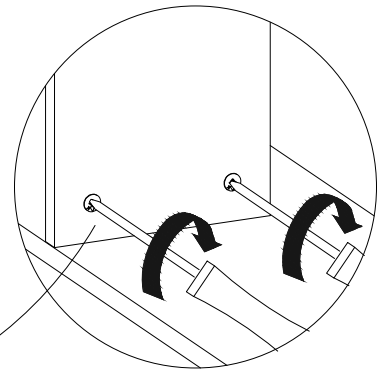
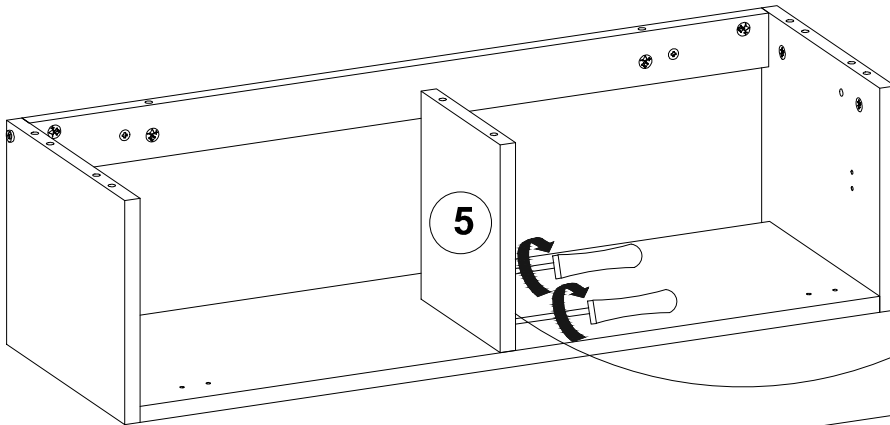
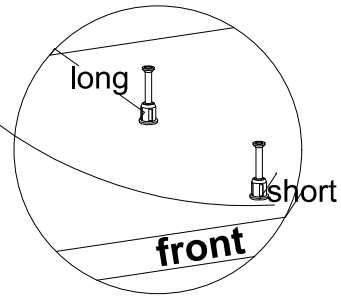
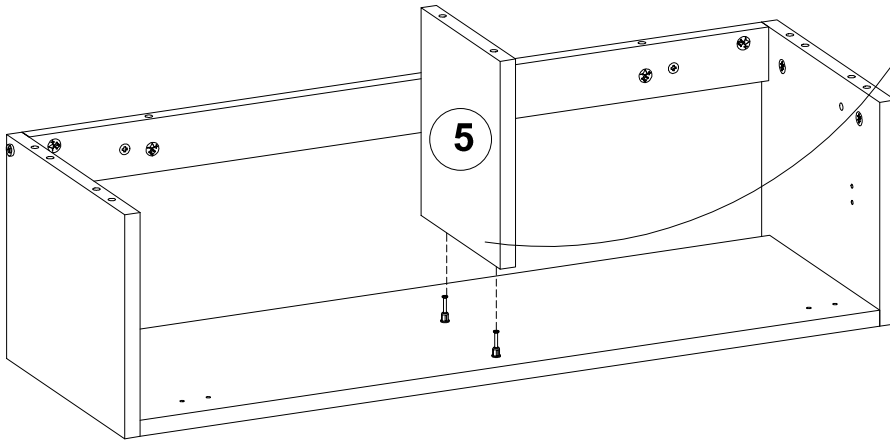


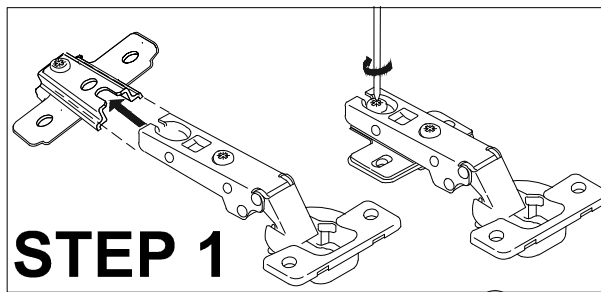
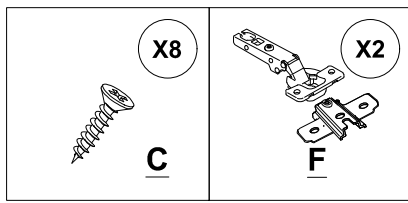
**STEP1**  
Then, position part number 1 at the desired height and use a spirit level to ensure it is parallel to the wall. Mark the screw hole positions on the wall with a pencil. If you don't have a fine-tipped pencil, you can press the L3 screw against the wall to leave a mark.



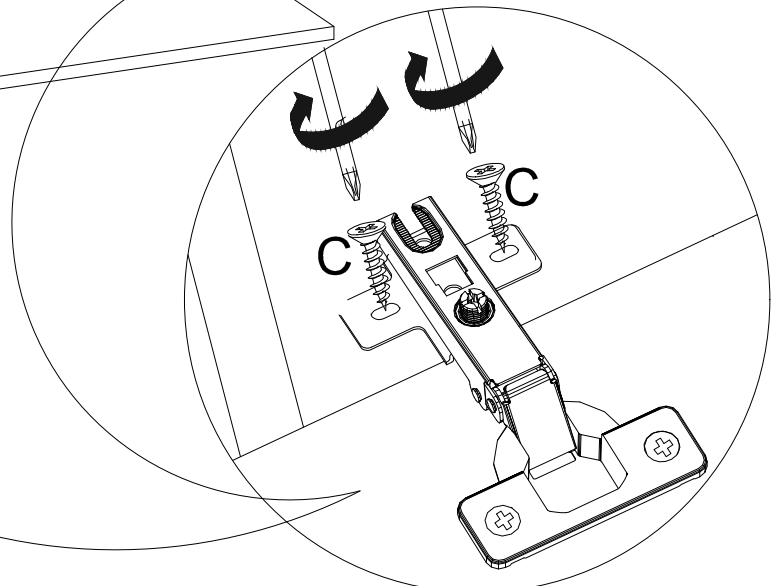
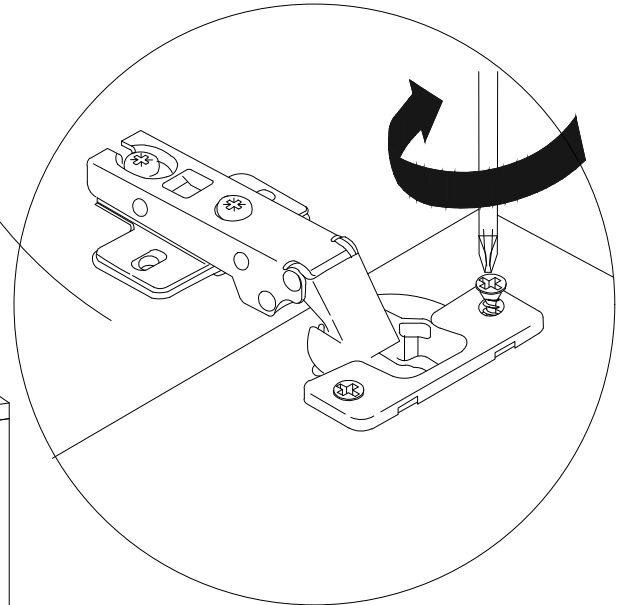
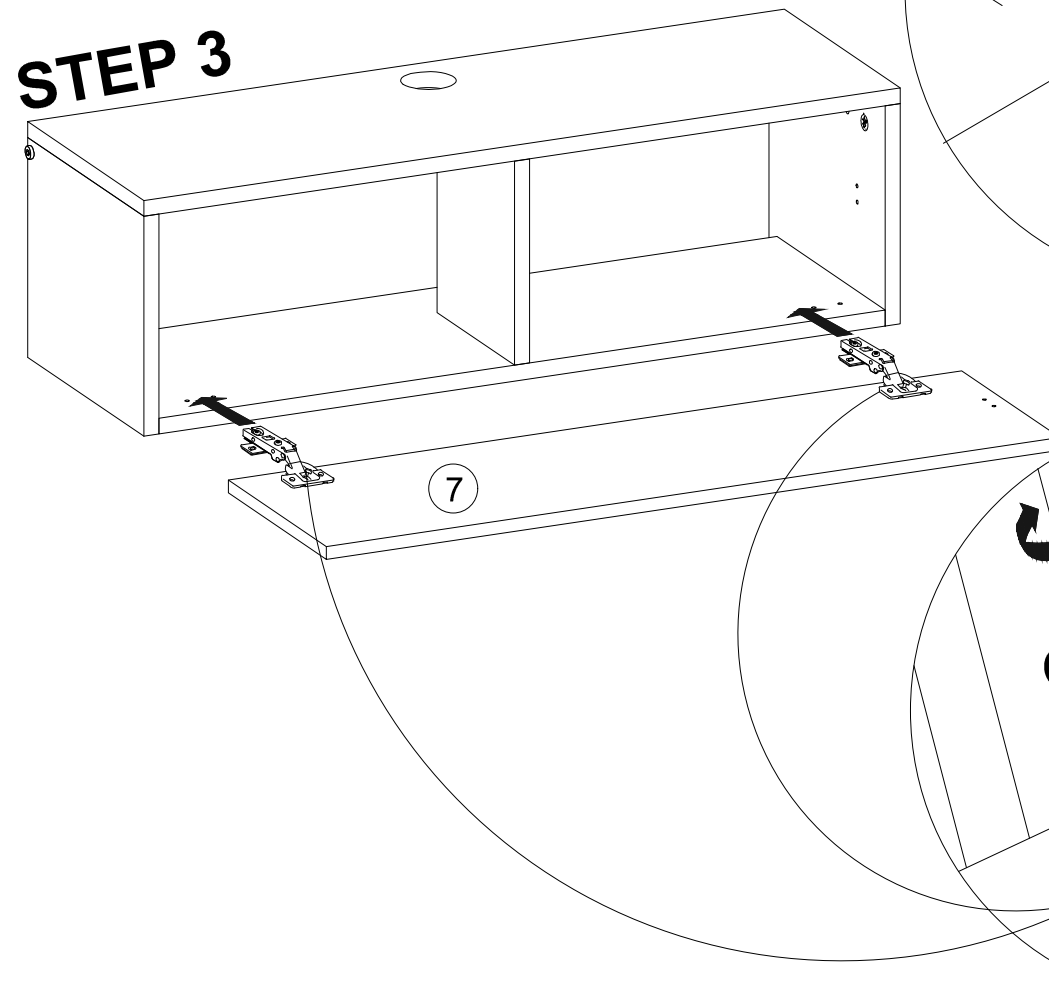
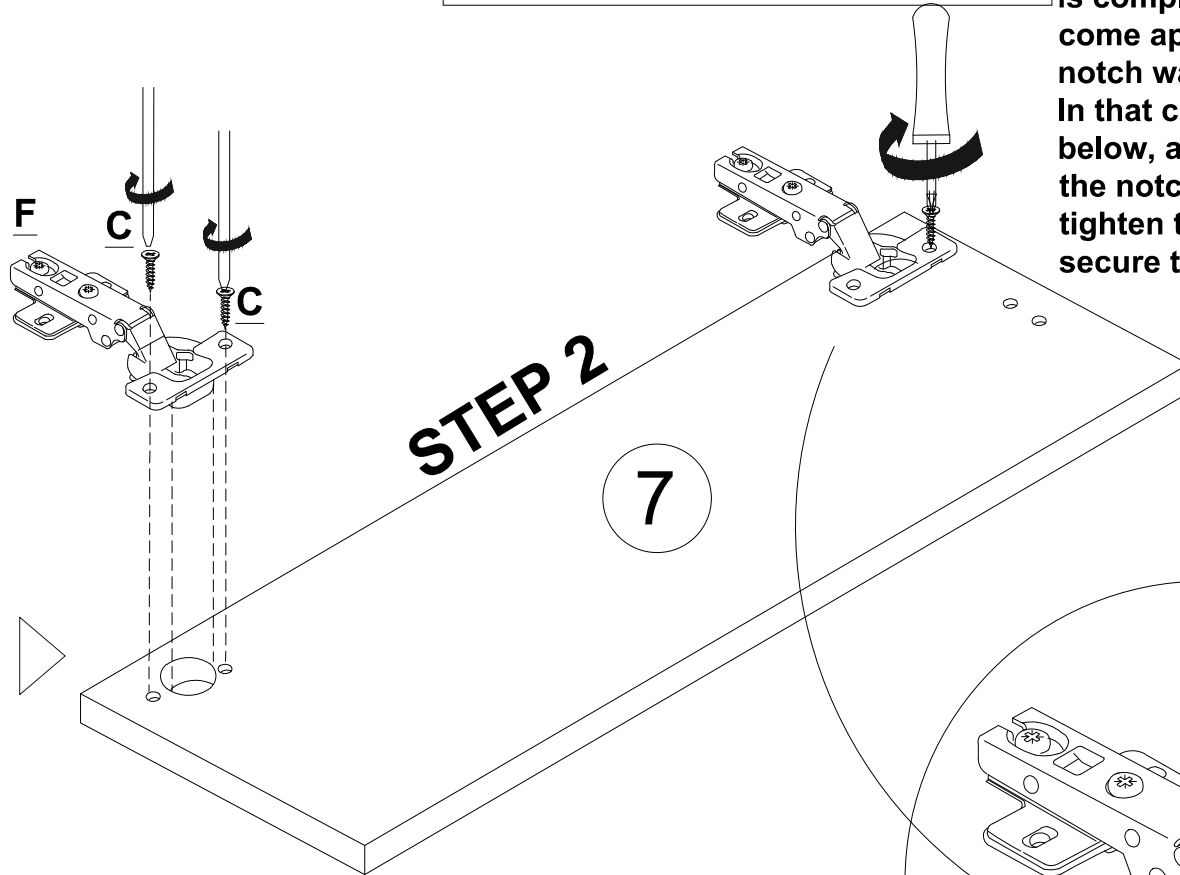


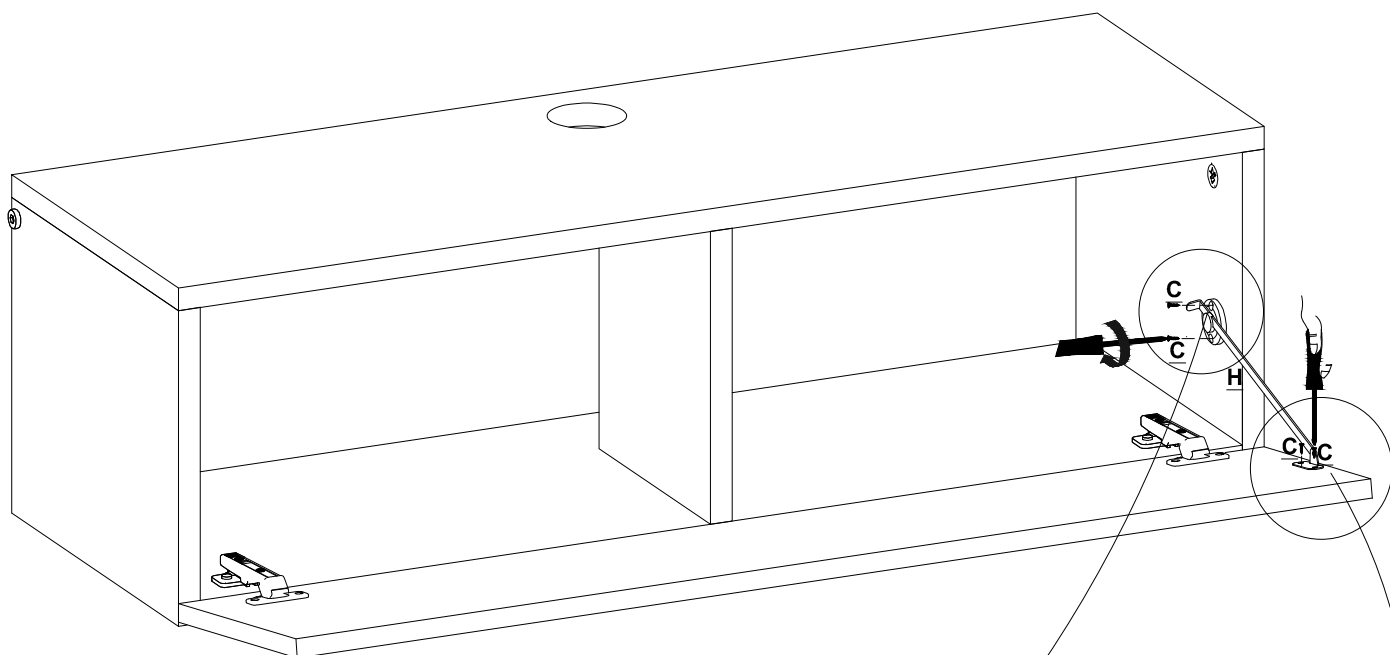
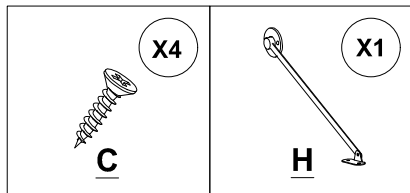
**\*\*The side of the bottom panel where the holes are closer should face forward.**



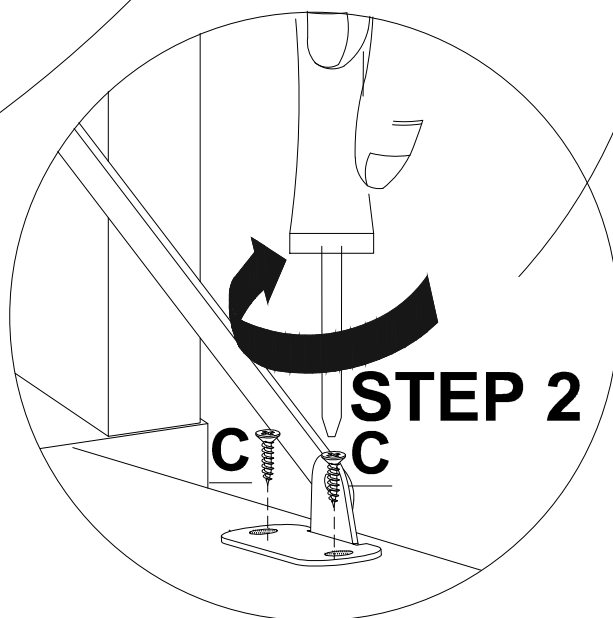
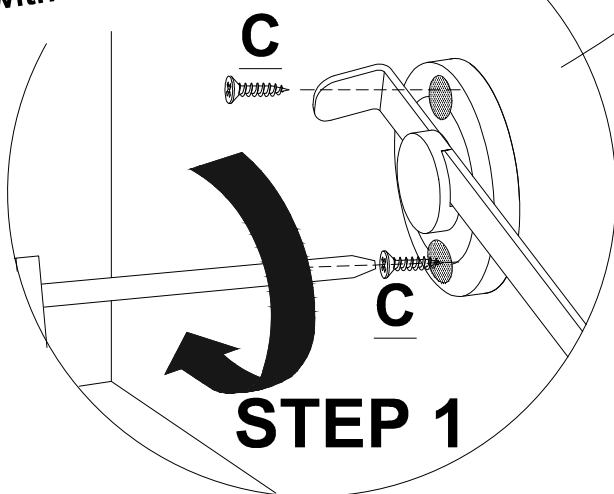


**\*\*As shown in the image, align these two parts so they fit snugly into the notch below. Make sure they are properly seated, then tighten the screw. Afterward, gently pull the pieces to check. If they don't separate, the process is complete! However, if they do come apart, it's likely that the notch wasn't properly aligned. In that case, loosen the screw below, adjust the parts to ensure the notch is correctly seated, and tighten the screw again. Finally, secure the bottom screw firmly.**





\* Lift up the door slightly and align the two holes on the door with the two holes on the lift-up support.





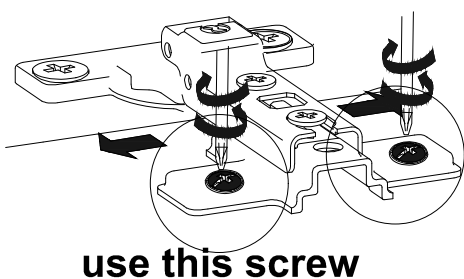

**\*\*After the modular installation is complete, gaps or height differences may occur between the modules due to any potential wall curvature. To prevent this, use a drill to slightly enlarge the partially opened holes, turning them into full holes, and connect the modules as shown in the diagram.**
